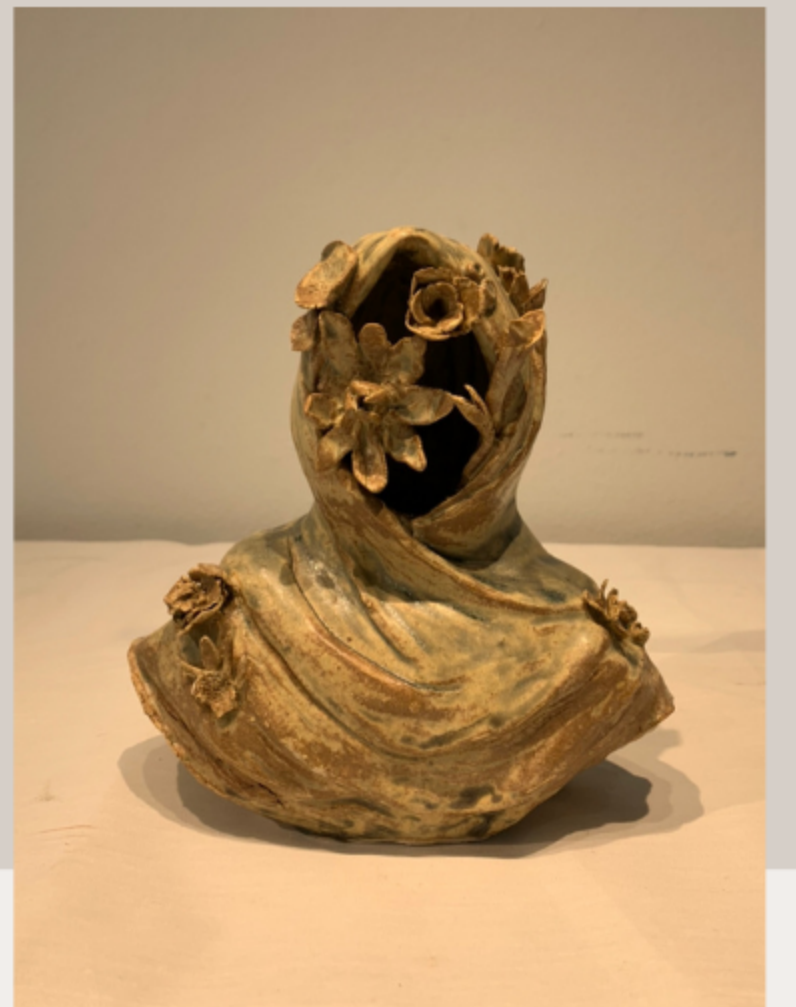

The Reliever
